RDA Conference Scholarships

CCSS is pleased to offer seven Registration Scholarships funded through Representative Democracy in America (RDA) and the Center for Education in Law and Democracy. The FAQs below lay out the details of what is covered, eligibility, and how to apply.

Q: What does a Conference Scholarship cover? A: The scholarship covers the conference registration fee and one year of membership in CCSS.

Q. Who may apply for a conference scholarship? A: Anyone can apply for the scholarship, but recipients must commit to attend the RDA session during the final session (2:40 - 3:35). This session will run a little longer than the other CCSS sessions, concluding around 4:00 pm.

Priority will be given to first time attendees and teachers traveling over 100 miles to participate in the conference. Applicants must be full-time K-12 school teachers.
